- ☞ The aim of the **Interdisciplinary Summer School on Religious Freedom** taking place in **July 19–24, 2020 in Warsaw** is to form the foundations of knowledge necessary for academic commitment to defend religious freedom and to protect religious minorities against persecution. The Summer School is organized by the **Institute of Justice** in Warsaw, Poland.
- ☞ The seminar will take the form of interdisciplinary lectures and workshops. Classes are given by lecturers from the University of Leuven (Belgium), University of Navarra (Spain), University of Oxford (United Kingdom), and the University of Warsaw (Poland). On the last day of the School a Forum of NGOs working with religious freedom and religious persecution will take place. In addition to experts, short presentations on these topics will be given by conference participants: **students, doctoral students, recent graduates and young scientists from various academic backgrounds.**
